### OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Upon receiving Jack, open release valve and pump handle several times. This will eliminate any airbound condition that may have occurred during shipment.
- 2. To raise Jack, close release valve and operate pump handle.
- 3. To lower, open release valve.

## FAILURE TO OPERATE

- 1. Release may not be completely closed.
- 2. Airbound See Instruction No.1.
- 3. Foreign matter in valve line Repeat Instruction No.1.
- 4. Too much oil Lower to filler screw level.
- 5. Interior parts may be worn allowing oil to by-pass. Contact nearest Franchised Service Depot.

## FAILURE TO LIFT LOAD

- 1. Airbound pump Operating Instructions No.1.
- 2. By-pass at valve balls Operating Instructions No.1. Reseat valve balls using small brass rod and hammer.
- 3. Foreign matter on release seat Operating Instructions No. 1.
- 4. Lack of oil With lifting arm down, fill to filler plug level.
- 5. Overload set too low Contact nearest Franchised Service Depot from list on back page.

#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Keep all moving parts well lubricated to prevent rust and excessive wear.
- 2. Repair Kit Number 5-549.

<u>CAUTION</u> - This Jack is designed for <u>lifting</u> purposes only.

Always use garage stands to support vehicle before making under-vehicle repairs.
