- Read, understand & follow these instructions and warnings before use.

PROPER SUCTION GUN USE

This Suction Gun should only be used for its designed purpose and according to the instructions in this manual.

GENERAL CAUTIONARY NOTES

Do not allow bystanders, children or other on-lookers in the work area as they can cause distractions, which may lead to mistakes and accidents.

Carefully inspect the equipment for damaged, loose or missing parts. If the unit is worn or damaged, do not use it.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Attach the 12" clear plastic tube to the fitting at the end of the suction gun.

Note: Oil can be used to lubricate the fitting if it is too tight.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Pull back the "T" shaped handle to operate.

Note: Place a finger over the end of the tube to stop any fluids from leaking or dripping after removal. Fluids that are difficult to extract when cold can be easier to extract when warmed up by operating the vehicle.

To force out the fluid from the suction gun, push the "T" shaped handle into the barrel.

Note: Whenever adding fluids, make sure the gun is cleaned before filling with clean fluid.
